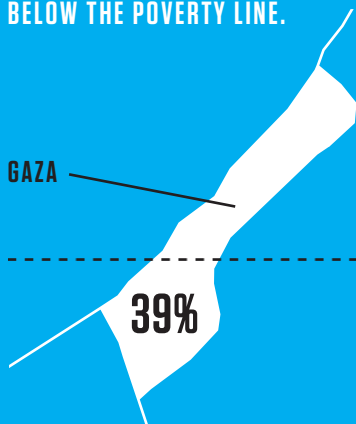

POVERTY

39 PER CENT OF THE POPULATION LIVES BELOW THE POVERTY LINE.



MANUFACTURING OUTPUT REDUCED BY 28 PER CENT COMPARED TO 2013.

AGRICULTURAL OUTPUT

THE OUTPUT FROM THE AGRICULTURE SECTOR IS ESTIMATED TO HAVE SHRUNK BY 31 PER CENT COMPARED TO 2013.



UNEMPLOYMENT

UNEMPLOYMENT IS 43 PER CENT INCREASED BY 11 PERCENT.

YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT IS 67 PER CENT (NUMBER OF UNEMPLOYED YOUTH INCREASED FROM 48,000 IN THE SECOND QUARTER OF 2013 TO 110,000 IN THE SECOND QUARTER OF 2014) PALESTINIAN CENTRAL BUREAU OF STATISTICS.

40,000 PEOPLE EMPLOYED IN THE AGRICULTURE/FISHERY SECTOR WERE AFFECTED.

ELECTRICITY

DAILY POWER OUTAGES OF 16-18 HOURS IN SOME AREAS OF GAZA IN FEBRUARY 2015.

ELECTRICITY DEFICIT INCREASED BY ALMOST 20 PER CENT, REACHING ABOUT 65 PERCENT.



RIGHT TO EDUCATION

30 PER CENT OF EDUCATION FACILITIES SUSTAINED DAMAGE OR WERE DESTROYED.

50 PER CENT OF KINDERGARTENS DAMAGED OR DESTROYED.

ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE

20 PER CENT OF THE POPULATION IS IN NEED OF LONG TERM MENTAL HEALTH ASSISTANCE.



PRELIMINARY ESTIMATES INDICATE UP TO 1,000 OF AT LEAST 2955 INJURED CHILDREN WILL BE PERMANENTLY DISABLED.
