Thank you for your letter of Nov. 19<sup>th</sup> setting out the Minister's interpretation of the meaning of suspicious activity within the Minister's Directive relating to street checks.

It is not clear to the ANSDPAD Coalition that the interpretation is accurate. You asked us to respond by Nov. 25<sup>th</sup> to the legal analysis that you set out.

As you know, the Coalition does not have any legal resources. The street check matter took some three years and two well-funded academic and legal reports to resolve. We will need to take more time to complete a more fulsome legal analysis. Consequently, we are not able to register agreement with the DOJ's position.
